

# **TDP Planning Sheet**

## Plan your progress through the TDP

The pace of your progress through the TDP is up to you, as long as you complete a track while enrolled at Columbia. Requirements for the Foundational Track could technically be fulfilled within a semester, and requirements for the Advanced Track could be fulfilled within two years. However, due to the timing of teaching opportunities and the many other obligations of graduate student life, you may wish to pursue TDP track completion over a longer period of time.

For your convenience, here is an overview of the availability of TDP track elements:

TDP requirement	Availability
Preparing to Teach	Guidance available anytime in CTL's online Orientation to Teaching
Essentials of Teaching and Learning series	Four session sequence each semester
Pedagogy workshops	Many each semester
Application and Practice: Practice Teaching (Microteaching)	Sessions scheduled during semester, custom sessions by request
Application and Practice: Teaching Observations	Scheduled by request
Application and Practice: Mid-Course Reviews	Scheduled by request
Seminars and institutes	At least one seminar each semester, including summers
